



## Langtang Ganja La pass



### Introduction

Langtang Ganjala Pass trek starts from Syabru Besi lies in an upper Langtang valley center north part of Nepal combine with Helambu region. Ganjala pass is one of the difficult and famous high passes of Nepal which required good physical fitness as well equipment. From Sybru Bensi, you will follow the Langtang river to the east until you get to Kyanching Gompa 3,049m. Some 5 km to the south of Kyanching Gompa are the peaks of Naya Kanga 5,846m and , to the south east, Ponggen Dopku 5,930m. Kyanching Gompa is surrounded by Mt Langtang Lirung 7,245m. on the west, Yala peak on the north , Dorje Lakpa 6,966m. Urkeinmang 6,387m. Loenpo Gang 6,979m and Kangchenpo on the north-east. In Kyanjin Gompa there are a small Buddhist monastery and a cheese factory started in 1955 by the Swiss Association for Technical Assistance.

Ganjala pass trek is a great choice for nature lovers and adventurers seekers. The excellence views of snow capped mountains , Varieties of ethnicity, wildlife, flora and fauna is the highlights of Ganjala pass trekking. Upper Langtang Ganjala Pass provides the perfect environments of rivers, forests and high soaring peaks. Witnessing the Tamangs attired in traditional Tibetan gowns adds to the rich cultural experience. Lantang Ganja-la pass 5122 meters trekking offers panoramic Himalayan views, lush valley and beautiful Helambu Valley.

Ganjala trek begins from Shyabru Besi passing through Langtang village, trekking trail are heading to Naya Kanga Base camp. Langtang Ganjala Pass Trek starts from Sybru Bensi, ends at Melamchi Pul Bazar.

- **Day 8** : Trek to Ganja La phed (4,000m/13,120ft): 5 hrs. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 9** : Cross the Ganja La pass (5,122m/16,800 ft) Trek to Keldang (4,250m/13,940ft): 7 hrs Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 10** : Trek to Yak Kharka (4,000m/13,120ft): 3 hrs. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 11** : Trek to Tarke Gyang (2,590m/8,497ft): 3 hrs. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 12** : Trek to Sermathang (2,610m/8,563ft): 3-4 hrs. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 13** : Trek to Melamchi Pul Bazar: Drive to Kathmandu: 3/4 hrs trek/ 2 hr drive. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 14** : Departure day from Kathmandu (1,264m). Meal includes: Breakfast


## Cost and payment details

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. ## Why we don't include cost in our website?

**NOTE:** To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains will affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions in two ways in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which differ in the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
