



## Saribung Pass 6,328m Pass Trek



### Introduction

Saribung pass (6328m) Trek is challenging, physical demanding and very popular trekking trail with beaten track and difficult pass of Nepal. Situated to the north isolated part of Mustang region of Damodar Himal, the last frontiers close to the border of China (Tibet). newly discovered trekking route in 2006. Saribung Pass Trek could be described as one of the most beautiful high Himalaya pass. Into the barren high and wild nation east of Luri the trail presently heads southwards to the Damodar Kund Lake, a pilgrimage journey site of Shiva. From the lake the rising is intense, frequently on snow and even cold ice fields, to the Saribung pass (6232m). The trek offers to explore different local villages, picturesque mountains, monasteries, culture, tradition, and religion of Tibetan lifestyle.

Even for mountaineer it is easy to do Expedition but there are many passes with ice and creases in between the Damodar Kunda region and Nar-Phu valley. The crossing of the exciting Saribung La Pass trek offers adventurous souls, the opportunity to cross many high mountains passes covered with snow and will see remote valleys situated between the Damodar Kunda and Nar-Phu Valley. The rugged trails, ancient culture merge in a very unique interpretation of lands forgotten by time. Cutting high into cliff sides and passing through small Buddhist villages that have changed little over the centuries on this stunning traverse from Mustang, we cross numerous high passes including the De Hults Pass (6,225m) and emerge to the Annapurna region. In order to allow for as much acclimatization as possible before crossing the 18,000-foot Saribung La 6,328m Pass, Beginning our approach from the culturally-rich Buddhist region of Upper Mustang our trek in a clockwise direction starting from Jomsom and follow Upper Mustang trail and descend to the remote Nar-Phu valley and end at Besisahar before joining the Annapurna Circuit trail trek.

This trek can be possible in anti-clockwise for which the trek begins from Phu and later rise to Saribung pass and enter in the Mustang "Concealed Valley" or "Hidden Kingdom of Nepal" and then come back to Jomsom. and of course the spectacular mountain scenery from the top of Saribung La is memorable. The Saribung Pass Trek starts from one place to another with great diversity in scenery, beautiful landscapes, cultures, interaction with locals, religion and geographical variations. Hence trekkers can enjoy the fantastic and picturesque views of diversity in this region.

- **Day 3** : Fly to Jomsom. Trek to Kagbeni (2,800m/9,156 ft), 4 hrs Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 4** : Trek from Kagbeni to Chele (3,100m/10,137 ft), 5-6 hrs Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 5** : Trek from Chile to Gheling (3,570m/11,674 ft), 6-7 hrs Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 6** : Trek from Geling to Tsarang (3,560m/11,641 ft), 6 hrs Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

- **Day 13** : Trek to Saribung Base Camp (4,950m/16,186 ft), 6 hrs. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

- **Day 15** : Trek to Camp I (5,730m/18,737), 6 hrs. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

- **Day 17** : Trek to Nagoru 4400 m via Saribung Pass (6,020m/19,685 ft), 6 hrs. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 18** : Trek from Nagoru to Phu Gaon (4,080m/13,342 ft), 6 hrs Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 19** : Trek from Phu Gaon to Meta (3,560m/11,641 ft), 6 hrs Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 20** : Trek from Meta village to Koto (2,600m/8,502 ft), 6 hrs. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 21** : Trek from Koto to Dharapani village (1,860m/6,082 ft), 6 hrs. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner



- **Day 22** : Trek to Jagat village (1,300m/4,251 ft), 5 hrs. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 23** : Trek to Bhulbhule (840m/2,747 ft), 6 hrs. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 24** : Drive back to Kathmandu and Transfer to Hotel. Meal includes:Breakfast/Dinner

**NOTE:** To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing

including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp support, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.

3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip.
