



## Pikey Peak Trekking from Dhap



### Introduction

Pikey Peak Trekking Pikey is situated at Lower region of Solukhumbu district at an altitude of 4070 m. From Pikey peak, one can get the grand view of nature, can experience the traditional livings of different ethnic groups like Sherpa, Chhetri, Tamang and Gurung. Tourists can taste the varieties of local cuisines and observe some rare plants and animals. Likhupikey Rural Municipality of Ward no. 1 of Solukhumbu district and Pikey region of Ward No 8 of Solu dudhkunda rural Municipality is considered as the most important places of natural and biological variety. Tourists can observe the best view of the highest peak of the world Mt. Everest in the short trek. From Pikey peak, one can get the grand view of mountain peaks like Dhaulagiri, Everest, Makalu, Kanchenjunga, Ama-Damlam, Lhotse, Nuptse, Numbur, Gaurisankhar, Langtang to the far west. Additionally, Pikey peak rewards tourists with one of the best sunrises and sunset views. It offers dense forests of Sunpati, Pine, Rhododendron whereas attraction of birds and animals like Lophophorus, Crimson Horned Pheasant, tiger, wild bear, Panda, Ghoral and so on. Similarly, Chauri Ghai, Nak, yak and cow can be found anywhere in this area.

Tourists can have pleasing view at nature's unique scenes, villages and living way of Sherpa, Tamang, Chhetri, Gurung and Sunmuwar. To reach Pikey peak, bus or jeep ride from Bamtibhandar of Ramechhap district -the Okhaldhunga dhap-Khinji Phalate -Salleri of Solukhumbu district and then trek can be followed. Other alternative can be flight to Paplu airport of Solukhumbu district. The villages belonging to Likhu Pikey rural municipality include villages like Chaulakharka, Gole. Similarly, other villages of Solu dudhkunda municipality like Kerung, Taping, Tamakhani, Gorakhani, Salleri and Junbesi also lies at Likhu Pikey rural municipality. Likewise, other villages of Okhaldhunga district and Ramechhap district such

as Patale, Kiji Demba and Bamtibhandar are also the part of Likhu Pikey Peak Trek.

- **Day 2** : Kathmandu to Dhap 2900m. 7-8 hours drive Lodge camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 3** : Dhap to Japrey 2930m. 6-7 hours drive Lodge camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 4** : Jiprey to Pikey Base Camp 3600m. 6-7 hours walk Lodge camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 5** : Pikey Base Camp – Pikey Peak 4070m. Junbesi 7-8 hours walk, Lodge camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 6** : Junbesi –Thupten Chholing 2800m. - Junbesi 4-5 hours walk Lodge camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 7** : Junbesi – Chiwang 9000 feet -Phaplu 5-6 hours walk Lodge cam. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 8** : Phaplu – Kathmandu 8 hours car/ jeep ride or 40 minutes of flight. Included meals:Breakfast Dinner
- **Day 9** : Final Departure, Your adventure in Nepal comes to an end today!Included meals:Breakfast

## Why we don't include cost in our website?

**NOTE:** To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
