



Churen Himal Peak (7385m)



Introduction

Churen Himal 7371m (24,183ft) in Dhaulagiri Himalayan range is popular climbing peak above 7000 meters. It was first climbed by the Academic Alpine Club of Shizuoka Expedition team in 1970 by Mr. Kr. Fukui and K. Hasegawa. Churen Himal has three pinnacles which are called: Churen West 7371m/24,183ft., Churen Central 7375m/24,196ft and Churen North 7371m/24,183ft. Churen Himal was closed for climbing for some time and after the several request, Nepal Government has opened for climbing again. Located on the Mid West of Nepal Churen Himalaya it is one of the least and toughest peak to encounter. It is a part of Dhorpatan Hunting Reserve area at Jaljala range of high ridges. Many mountaineering party have successfully acclaimed victor on top of this high technical effort climb, but still this stunning Churen Himal. The area is completely apart from the mainstream path offering super breathtaking view of Dhaulagiri, Annapurna, Gurja Himal, Churen Himal and its wild valley.

Drive from Pokhara to Beni Bazaar Xtreme Climbers supporting crew will lead you to the foot of Churen Himal Base Camp for the classic and technical climb on top of this striking peak. Mesmerizing and fascinating adventure which involves a taste of almost all of the expeditions trekking environments which Nepal has to offer. Churen Himal Climbing provides you with an opportunity to explore the pristine area of Churen Himal, where you will have chance to visit into massif and beautiful Dhorpatan hills and valley. Our expedition' encounter through the nice and traditional farming villages of Chhetri, Magar and Chhantyal villages, where Gurjagaon has majority of Chhantyal a near extinct tribe of Nepal.

- **Day 4** : Drive from Pokhara to Darbang (1110m/3,641ft) 5 hrs. Lodge accommodation. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 5** : Trek from Darbang to Takum via Dharapani village (1670m/5,479ft.) 5 hrs. Camping accommodation. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 6** : Trek from Takum to Lumsang village (2120m/6,955ft.) 6 hrs. Camping accommodation. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 7** : Trek from Lumsang to Gurja Village (2620m/8,595ft.) 7 hrs.Camping accommodation. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner

- **Day 31** : Trek from Burjunga Khark- Gurja village (2620m/8,595ft) 6 hrs.Camping accommodation. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 32** : Trek from Gurjagoan village to Lulang village(2200m/7,218ft.) 5 hrs. Camping accommodation. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 33** : Trek from Lulang to Dharapani to Darbang (1670m/5,479ft.) 5 hrs. Tea house accommodation. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 34** : Drive from Darbang to Pokhara via Beni overnight at hotel accommodation. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 35** : Fly 25 minutes from Pokhara to Kathmandu or Drive from Pokhara to Kathmandu (1350m/4,429ft) 6-7 hrs. Hotel accommodation in Kathmandu. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 36** : Final Departure

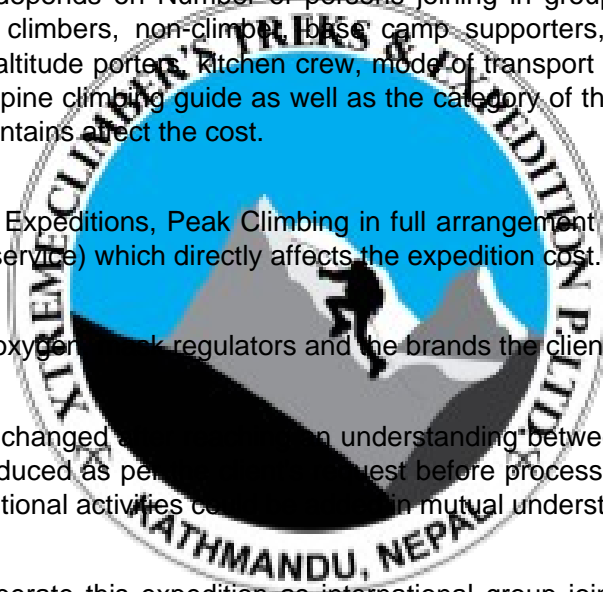
Cost and payment details

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. Additional activities may be added as per trekkers request with appropriate additional cost. For Total Tour cost **EMAIL US**, we will send you within 24 hours as your requirements.

Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen tank regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed with a mutual understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per client request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
6. Either you want to operate this expedition as international group joining basics of Xtreme Climbers or individual (private arrangement) expedition.
7. Type of high camp food that clients require. Any specialized food that has to be ordered from foreign countries will be costlier compared to the one available here.
8. Either any of the climbers intend to attempt any world records? If so, do they require special services or equipment?
