



Singu Chuli (6501m)



Introduction

Formerly known as the Fluted Peak, the first ascent of the Singu-Chuli Peak was made by Wilf Noyce and David Cox on its North-East Face and the top section of the East Ridge. The Fluted peak has proved to be a demanding attempt for most commercial climbing groups that concentrate on Tent Peak. Singu Chuli 6,501m is the 3rd highest amongst the "Trekking Peaks" of Nepal and situated in the Annapurna Sanctuary adjoined to Tharpu Chuli and across Hiunchuli trekking peaks placing a privileged, splendid amphitheatre of glaciers and nodes with, in background the mythical southern face of Annapurna. The first summit on the long ridge thrown down from Tarke Kang (Glacier Dome), which separates the South and West Annapurna Glaciers. Climbing Singu Chuli required good knowledge of technical climbing skills specially on summit day, such as walking with crampons, zoomers, figure of eight to rappel down so it is preferable that you have used these previously. We recommend expedition participants to train hard as this is a physically demanding peak climbing trip in the Annapurna region. However, it can be climbed by an amateur mountaineer with basic climbing experience.

Encounter with many regular Annapurna Base Camp trekkers sharing warm cozy dining with them until Machhapuchhre (Fishtail) Base camp and acclimatization hike to famed Annapurna Base Camp is an exceptional part of the trip. Singu Chuli peak climbing leads through beautiful Gurung's helmets above the Modi River upstream. You will entertain great cultural and natural sites while approaching the Singu Chuli climb. Despite all these six days set aside for the summit Singu Chuli including climbing clinic with full support of Xtreme Climbers highly experienced helping crew and Climbing Sherpa Guide and member in high qualities tented camp. Leading to the Singu Chuli expedition through narrow gully

being the most challenging segment of the trip. Climbing the much stiffer proposition below the Summit is some technical difficulties on this climb, however the views from the top are astounding and make all the tough effort worthwhile.

- **Day 1 :** Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu. Arrival in Kathmandu [1300 m/4264 ft] Arrive at any time
- **Day 2 :** Sightseeing around Kathmandu, overnight at hotel. Included meals: Breakfast Dinner
- **Day 3 :** Departure for Pokhara, overnight at hotel. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 4 :** Trek to Tolka, overnight at guesthouse. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 5 :** Trek to Jhinu, overnight at guesthouse. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner

The cost is depending on group size, due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
