



Mera Peak (6476m)



Introduction

Xtreme Climbers presents Mera Peak Climb, an exclusive adventure around hidden areas of Khumbu and Everest, leading towards due east around beautiful Inkhu valley, where you will walking in dense alpine woodland of tall pine-firs-birch and rhododendron tree lines, in the backdrop of high and giant peaks that surrounds the scenic areas of Inkhu valley.

Truly an adventure of great fascinating moments on the least trekking trails, where travelers seldom venture around hidden Inkhu valley of rich vegetation and beyond to remorseless fields of ice and glaciers.

Mera Peak Climb, where it leads you to the summit top at 6,461 m / 21, 1907 ft high, without much technical difficulties, a straight forward climbing adventure an ideal peak to climb for all types of people from beginners to hard core mountaineers, as Mera Peak one of the highest trekking peak in Nepal Himalaya.

The grade PD 'Per Difficulte' which means of less technical difficulty walking on ice and moraine where ice-axe and crampons required, along with main / fix ropes in some sections of the climb for pure safety measures, where our Xtreme Climbers expert guides will lead you to the summit top and back in safe and sound conditions with much enjoyable and exciting moment during Mera Peak Climb.

The grade we have taken from French and Swiss Alpine Climbing System which is popularly used world-wide on alpine climb.

Our Mera Peak climb starts with short scenic flight to Lukla and then heading remote areas of Khumbu which is south of Mt. Everest close to Mt. Baruntse and towards Makalu area, walk leads to cross high Zatwar-la pass of Naulekh and Kalo Himal ridges to reach the hidden Inkhu valley and then at Mera Peak base camp for adventurous climb.

After an exciting moment of great thrill heading back to Lukla on achieving our goal with successful climb on Mera Peak Climb.

- **Day 4** : Paiya to Panggom (2,846m/9,337ft): 4-5 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 5** : Panggom to Ningsow (2,863m/9,393ft): 4-5 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 6** : Ningsow to Chhatra Khola (3,900m/9,186ft): 5-7 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 7** : Chhatra Khola to Kothe (4,350m/14,271ft): 5-6 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 8** : Kothe to Thagnak (4,350m/14,271ft): 4 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 9** : Thagnak to Khare (5,045m/16,547ft): 5-6 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climb during the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
