



Cholatse Peak (6440m)



Introduction

Cholatse Peak stands proudly at 6,361 m high, the mountain with local name as Jobo Lhaptshan, located around high Khumbu valley within Everest region. This sharp mountain is closely connected with another close peak Taboche 6,542m by a long ridge. Cholatse Peak Climb of highly technical effort and difficulty than any other trekking peaks in Nepal Himalaya where only few climbers have made to the summit of this peak. The north and east faces of Cholatse can be seen from Thug-la or Dughla, on the trek to Everest Base Camp. This tough and stunning peak was first climbed via southwest ridge on April 22, 1982 by Vern Clevenger, Galen Rowell, John Rowell and Bill O'Connor. Cholatse Peak climb grade as TD means 'Technical Difficult' used as per French and Swiss Alpine Climbing Classification System and used popularly worldwide for alpine style climb.

A peak of technical effort with straightforward climb, knowing the nature of difficulty we have allowed many days to make the climb a huge success. The north face was successfully scaled in 1984 by veteran climbers so you can join in this extreme adventure climb where you will trekking around high valleys of the Khumbu with time to explore villages and monasteries and to sample the incredible hospitality of the Sherpa people. Cholatse Peak Climb adventure begins with a sweeping flight to Lukla and then reaching slowly to Phakding as the trek progress entering into Sherpa capital at Namche Bazaar.

With time to acclimatize, before following the quiet trail to Gokyo high valley and visiting the ancient Buddhist monastery as the walk leads beyond tree lines to reach arid and barren rocky and ice terrains at Gokyo Lake with incredible views of world 6th highest Mt. Cho-Oyu at close distance. At Gokyo with fantastic panorama from the high scenic view point at

Gokyo Ri, walk continues to cross Thso-la pass and towards our main goal and highlight of the adventure for Cholatse climb, we have allowed enough time for the tough and challenging climb of high technical sections in few places, where our expert team of Sherpa guides will lead you to the summit top with safe and exciting climb at the top enjoy the panorama of world highest peaks with Mt. Everest and magnificent Amadablam at mere distance. After an overwhelming moment around complete isolation for many days return journey via an alternative route with a visit of Pangboche and Thyangboche monasteries of immense interest and delights, walk slowly ends as the path approaches at Lukla for last overnight around Khumbu and Everest.

A scenic panoramic flight brings you back to Kathmandu with memorable and exciting time on Cholatse Peak Climb and around Gokyo Valley with great guidance and services of Xtreme Climbers and its expert guides.

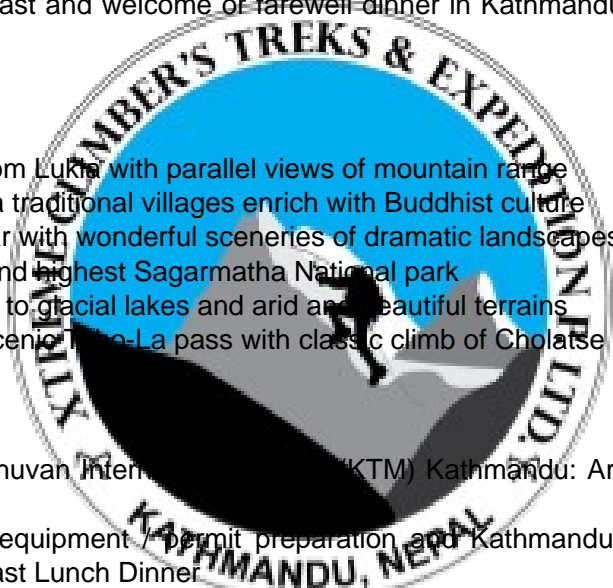

- **Day 1 :** Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu: Arrival in Kathmandu [1300 m/4264 ft] Arrive at any time,
- **Day 2 :** Kathmandu equipment / permit preparation and Kathmandu valley sightseeing, overnight in Kathmandu. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 3 :** Lukla (fly) trek to Phakding 3.30 hours, O/N Lodge. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 4 :** Trek to Namche Bazar 6 hours, O/N Hotel. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 5 :** Namche Bazar – Acclimatization day. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 6 :** Trek to Dole 6 hours, O/N Lodge. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 7 :** Trek to Machherma 5 hours, O/N Lodge. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner

- **Day 16 :** Trek to Photse 5/6 hours, overnight lodge. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 17 :** Trek to Namche Bazaar (3446m, overnight lodge. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 18 :** Trek to Lukla, overnight hotel. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 19 :** Fly to Kathmandu transfer to hotel, overnight Kathmandu evening time Farewell dinner with traditional Nepali Dance. Included meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 20 :** Final Departure

Cost and payment details

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.

4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
6. Either you want to operate this expedition as international group joining basics of Xtreme Climbers or individual (private arrangement) expedition.
7. Type of high camp food that clients require. Any specialized food that has to be ordered from foreign countries will be costlier compared to the one available here.
8. Either any of the climbers intend to attempt any world records? If so, do they require special services or equipment?
