



## Chulu Far East (6059m)



### Introduction

Chulu Far East Climbing. Chulu Massif rises north of the Marshyangdi River in the Manang region and form part of the Manang Himal, which is quite rightly included in the larger Damodar Himal. This remote upland area lies to the north of and in a rain shadow formed by the main Annapurna Himal. It is one of Nepal's premier trekking destinations. With its stunning panoramic views of some of the famous highest summits of the Himalaya. Some are Manaslu 8,156m, Annapurna I 8,091m, Annapurna II 7,937m, Annapurna III 7,555m, Annapurna IV 7,525m, Dhaulagiri 8,167m, Gangapurna 7,455m. and the holy Machapuchare 6,993m. The Chulu Far East peak (6,059m) first climbed in 1955 by a German expedition lies to the north of the main Annapurna Himal. Chulu Far East (6,059m) peak climbing is one of the best and Moderate climbing Peaks in Nepal. 45 degree climbing and not technically difficult peak and we will settle a high camp near col at about the altitude 5,350m. From the col we follow the long South-West ride on snow and ice to the summit. The trek approach goes through the Annapurna Circuit, It is not overly difficult and the terrain passes through monsoon rain forest and rhododendron forest is one of the beautiful experiences. This trek is regarded as one of the best trek that offers so much of distinct sensation.

### Drive Kathmandu to Chame

We will take a drive from Kathmandu towards Chame which is the beginning point of our journey. Through narrow ascending trails surrounded by dense forests until arriving at Pisang. We continue our walk to Humde Village where we will see longest prayer wheels and hanging prayer flags and head towards Junu Khola. After spending a day acclimatization at Junu Khola. We continue our trek on a climbing trail to Chulu Far East Base Camp with a crossing of

some risky rocks. We will spend the more day for acclimatization Chulu Far East Base Camp with climbing training. Not only, but we will also do some preparation and the short hike up to surrounding glaciers. After base camp, we walk through snow slopes to reach high camp 5500m. Besides, our adventurous trek is also rewarded with splendid views of Annapurna mountain ranges. Furthermore

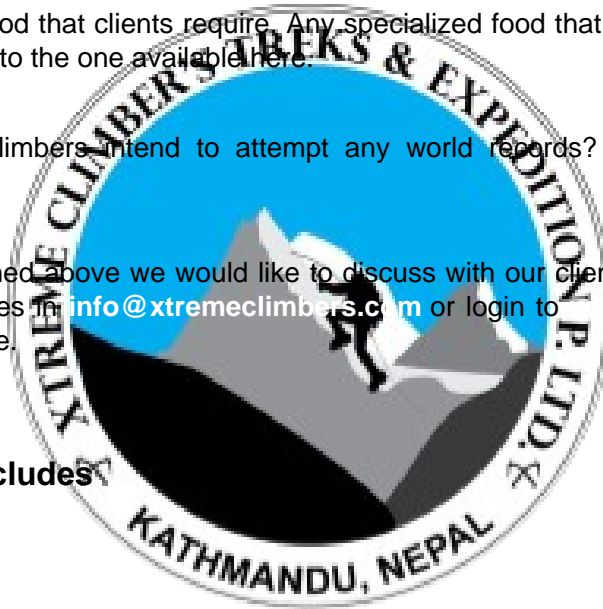
Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.

2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip.
