

Manaslu Round Trek



Introduction

Mt Manaslu is situated on the borders of Nepal and Tibet. Manaslu Trek is one of the most challenging and well-known trails in Nepal. It provides an amazing view of some of the highest mountain peaks in the world.

Manaslu circuit trekking trail goes through the traditional village of Hindu and Buddhist religious settlement. During the Manaslu circuit trek, you can explore the panoramic views of kind snow-capped mountain ranges ie. Mt. Manaslu, Ganesh etc. The Manaslu trekking trail commences from Soti Khola which is the low altitude point then the altitude rises constantly up to Laekya La pass (5125m).

The wonderful landscapes, green countryside, lush forests and the gorgeous views of the huge glacier and snow-capped mountain make of trip extra special. Manaslu Circuit Trekking trail is a restricted area for the sole trek. So, you need at least two trekkers and a registered local trekking guide to trek in Manaslu region.

The trek can be as short as 10 days for Lower Manaslu trek and could be extended to 21 days with an amazing side trip to Tsum Valley. Every itinerary comes with rest days in Sama Gawn and Samdo. These two places are for the overnight stay with one day for acclimatization. It is also possible to go somewhere during the rest days. For example, side trips to either Manaslu Base Camp or Punggyen Gompa are possible from Sama Gaon, while a day hike towards the Tibetan border could also be made from Samdo. The next village after Samdo, called Dharmasala, has a temporary settlement (i.e. only one teahouse that can accommodate a large volume of trekkers!) and is open during the non-winter season only. One thing to note is that if the Dharmasala is closed, this would mean that Larke Pass is almost impassable as well; this normally happens during wintertime.

Why we dont't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement Xtreme Climbers desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

- 1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50%
- less than the spring season.

 The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining to group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing 2. including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
