



Tharpu Chuli (Tent Peak) 5,663 m



Introduction

Tharpu Chuli (Tent) Peak Climbing 5,663m. located in the heart of the Annapurna Sanctuary. Relatively low altitude, it is among only a few snow-covered summits in Nepal. Situated at the southern side of the ABC (Annapurna Base Camp) at an elevation of 5,663 m. The peak gives the stunning view of the gigantic snow capped Annapurna range. The superb picturesque at the trekking region gives suitable reason for climbing this peak. While walking and climbing along the Modi River area you will feel the spectacular natural majesty as well as the brilliant culture of renowned trekking area of Nepal. The majestic beauty of the forests with wild plants, dense forests, different types of plants and flowers.

The ascent is technically easy - a very pleasant climb even for less experienced mountaineers. This Climbing Trekking basically starts from the Pokhara in the Annapurna area. While walking to Dhapu, Landruk, and Chomrong you can see the absolute mountainous surrounding of Dhaulagiri 8,167m as well as Annapurna 8,091m. with different types of plants and some wild creatures. While trekking, you can experience the local cultures and lifestyles as well the hospitality of the local people including panoramic views of the Himalayan range, streams, waterfalls, ethnic people and their villages as well as the lush forests with red rhododendron.

From the beginning of the trekking to the end of the trail you will face the different landscape of Himalayan range. As you walk to the altitude you will face the buffer zone near to the Annapurna, which is one of the most fascinating area of this trip and also you will experience why it is renowned in Annapurna region. While walking we touch our feet to the Machhapuchhre Base Camp (M.B.C) and after that Annapurna Base Camp (A.B.C). From ABC our walk continues for the

Tharpu Chuli Base Camp. After we reach the peak we take same route until ABC and from ABC we descend down to Bamboo, Jhinu Danda and finally Nayapul.

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expedition and Mountain Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask, regulator, and the brand the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
6. Either you want to operate this expedition as international group joining basics of Xtreme Climbers or individual (private arrangement) expedition.
7. Type of high camp food that clients require. Any specialized food that has to be ordered from foreign countries will be costlier compared to the one available here.
8. Either any of the climbers intend to attempt any world records? If so, do they require special services or equipment?
