



Tsum Valley and Manaslu Larkey Pass



Introduction

Discover the secret Tibetan Buddhist land lying at the edge of one of the most secluded Himalayan valleys. Tsum Valley is one of world's remotest Himalayan Valleys which was also a restricted region until recently. The trek to Tsum Valley takes you into the majestic surroundings of the Ganesh Himal, Shringi Himal, and Boudha Himal ranges. The region once being part of Tibet looks completely different from what you will find elsewhere. The people of Tsum Valley or the Tsumbas belong to Tibetan origin with their own ancient form of dialect, art, culture and religion. Very few adventure travelers have made it to this high and mysterious valley, which used to be an important trade link with Tibet. In the initial days, we trek the route of Around Manaslu Trek or the Manaslu Circuit Trek. The Tsum Valley lies on the northern part of Manaslu and used to be a restricted area until 2008. The region is still less exposed in comparison to other touristy areas, with relatively virgin and less beaten paths in comparison to the more popular regions. The Tsum people have their own way of family life, which may be quite surprising for many outsiders. All the brothers in the family are married to a single girl, what you may call a practice of polyandry.

The trek start and end point is Arughat, a seven hours drive from Kathmandu. The first half of the trek ascends the Budhi Gandaki Valley on good paths through a mix of dense forest, terraced fields and hill villages. As we leave the main Manaslu Trail for the Tsum valley, suddenly we get a feeling of entering truly into the hidden valley. While on the trek, we also pass through the alpine forests, glacial rivers, and enjoy the warm hospitality of ethnic people. Pass the lower Buri Gandaki regions of Liding, Machha Khola, Jagat and Philim. We also visit the ancient Gombas of the region such as: Rachen Gompa, Mu Gompa, Dephyudonma Gompa.

- **Day 1** : Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu
- **Day 2** : Trek Preparation and Kathmandu Valley Sightseeing Tour. Meal Includes: Breakfast.
- **Day 3** : Kathmandu to Soti Khola (710m/2328 ft) via Arughat, duration: 8-9 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 4** : Soti Khola to Machha Khola (900m/2952 ft) Duration: 5-6 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 5** : Machha Khola to Philim (1590m/5215ft) Duration: 6 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 6** : Philim to Ripche (2470m/8101 ft) Duration: 6 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 7** : Ripche to Nile/Chule (3360m/11020 ft) visit Milarepa Piren Phu Cave, 8-9 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 8** : Nile/Chhule to Mu Gompa (2700m/12136ft), visit Dephyudonma Gompa, 5 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 9** : Mu Gompa to Rachen Gompa (2900m/10630 ft) Duration: 05 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 10** : Trek to Deng (1860m) Duration: 05 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 11** : Trek to Namrung (2900m/9512ft) Duration: 5 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 12** : Namrung to Lho Gham (3180m/10430ft) Duration: 3-4 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 13** : Trek to Samagaon (3500m/11480 ft) Duration: 6 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 14** : Acclimatization day at Samagaon. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 15** : Samagaon to Samdo (3690m/12103ft) Duration: 3 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 16** : Samdo to Dharamshala (4450 m/14596 ft) Duration: 4 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 17** : Trek to Bhimphedi (3590m/11775ft) via Cross Larkya La pass (5220m/17121 ft) Duration: 8 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 18** : Trek to Tilje (2300m/7544 ft) Duration: 5 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 19** : Trek to Chamje (1410m/4625 ft) Duration: 6-7 hrs. Meal Includes: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included.
- **Day 20** : Drive to Kathmandu (1337m) Duration: 8 hrs Meal includes: Breakfast and Lunch and Farewell dinner.
- **Day 21** : Final Departure

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbing in Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
